13. Fri. - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Our immigration appeals have all been denied. Pray as we discern what direction God has for us. Pray for our transition.
14. Sat - **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** - Pray for our Welsh Christian friends.
15. Sun - **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** - We are blessed to have one of our supervisors staying with us for a few days. Pray that our time spent together will be fruitful.
16. Mon - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 1)** - Please pray for our neighbors. We are trying to spend more time with them, but there has been a disagreement that has split the road. There are hurt feelings, and we do not want to be in the middle.
17. Tue - **Cymraeg (Welsh 4)** - C has started becoming more missional with his friends, and it's really great to see, pray for fruit in his ministry.
18. Wed - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - As we are forced off the field due to visa refusals please pray we finish well and that we can accomplish all God brought us here to do.
19. Thu - **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** - Pray for R and M, pastors at our local congregation.
20. Fri - **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** - Pray for language learning, because it is at the core of what we do.
21. Sat - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Pray for other colleagues in sister evangelical agencies who are also being refused visas and told they will have to leave Ireland. Is this a spiritual battle?
22. Sun - **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** - Pray that we will continue to build relationships and become a part of our community.
23. Mon - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Please, pray for us as we have our 2015 CeLT Annual General Meeting. This is going to be a time for the CeLT Team to meet, pray together, and grow in fellowship and devotion.
24. Tue - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 1)** - Please pray for us. We have both been very discouraged lately.

25. Wed - **Cymraeg (Welsh 4)** - pray for our church, Caersalem, they desire to reach the lost, and they are praying that they can be more effective in our community. Pray that God makes them doers of this passion and not just planners.
26. Thu - **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** - Please continue to pray for our language learning. It is difficult to continue learning at a rapid pace and easy to get bogged down in our own failings. Pray that we will focus on God's provision.
27. Fri - **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** - Pray for me as I connect with believers to find financial support to stay on field.
