3. Fri - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 1)** - Now that the weather is getting better and brightening up, we are having more opportunities to meet and talk with our neighbors and friends. Please pray for these conversations that they would be gospel-focused.
4. Sat - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Pray for R, a believer that we have recently met from our area
5. Sun - **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** - Today on Easter, pray that the people of Wales will know the Risen Savior.
6. Mon - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Pray for many of us on the Team as we participate in the Llanw conference with many of our Welsh Christian friends. Pray that it is a time of worship and connecting for the sake of the Kingdom.
7. Tue - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 1)** - During the Easter break, several of our friends will be off from work. Please pray that we will use this time wisely and spend more time with them and their families.
8. Wed - **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** - Pray for my fundraising, so I can stay in Wales!
9. Thu - **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** - Things are moving forward with a construction project with a local church. A construction team from Tennessee will be arriving at the end of the month. They will be working to complete the floor in the sanctuary.

10. Fri - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Pray for N, a man from our area and R's nephew who is sick with terminal cancer.
11. Sat - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Pray for me as I'll be sharing from the Word with Penrallt Baptist Church today both in the morning and the evening.
12. Sun - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 1)** - Very sadly, there have been a number of deaths and suicides in our area recently. Please pray for our community as they grieve.
13. Mon - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Pray for our kids as they go back to school after Easter break.
14. Tue - **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** - Pray for our language learning as we start back to class after a long break.
15. Wed - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Pray for our interactions between us and our landlord and neighbours.
16. Thu - **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** - Pray for our Welsh Christian friends.
17. Fri - **Cymraeg (Welsh 4)** - Please keep my friends M and L in prayer. We had a really good conversation about God a few weeks ago, but they haven't hung out with me since. Ask God to bring more conversations up with them.
18. Sat - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Pray for peace in our home and good interactions between us and our children.
19. Sun - **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** - Pray for R and M, pastors at our local congregation.
20. Mon - **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** - Pray for language learning, because it is at the core of what we do.
21. Tue - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Pray for me today as I have some medical tests done that hopefully will lead to effective treatment and greater effectiveness in ministry.
22. Wed - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Mr. Irish 2 starts back to school to learn Irish today. Pray for him as he studies and interacts with classmates.
23. Thu - **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** - Pray that we will continue to build relationships and become a part of our community.
24. Fri - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 1)** - We are having an amazing opportunity to share, witness, and study the Bible with a not-yet believer. Pray that God would use this time to speak to our friend in a powerful way.

25. Sat - **Cymraeg (Welsh 4)** - Pray for church plants here in Wales. I have talked to two different people about their desires to plant churches in the near future. Beg God that this happens.
26. Sun - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Pray for me today as I'll be sharing from the Word with Capel y Ffynnon in Bangor, both in the morning and evening.
27. Mon - **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** - Pray for me as I connect with believers to find financial support to stay on field.
28. Tue - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Mrs. Irish 2 has a toddler group with locals and meets them for tea about twice a week. Please pray for good interactions and opportunities to share Christ.
29. Wed - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Pray for meetings with potential ministry partners today that will lead to greater influence for the Gospel among Celtic peoples.
30. Thu - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Pray for safe arrival today of a Tennessee Team coming to help with a project together with some ministry partners in Caernarfon.
