1. Fri - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Please, pray for a construction team from Tennessee that will begin in earnest their work in renovating a local chapel building for better ministry capabilities to the community in a Welsh-speaking town.
2. Sat - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Please pray for last minute student summer missionary applications for this year, as 6 May is the first of two application deadlines.
3. Sun - **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** - Continue to pray for the construction team as they spend long hours working on renovating a local chapel. Pray that their work goes smoothly.
4. Mon - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Pray that leading up to and after the communion that we will have lots of conversations with people about why we do communion differently.
5. Tue - **Cymraeg (Welsh 4)** - Please be praying for our youth bible study. God has been blessing us with so many students coming, but our prayer is that leave equipped with the gospel to go and make disciples.
6. Wed - **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** - Please, pray for a summer team member that will leave the US today to travel to Wales. Pray for him as he starts his training to work as the team's assistant project coordinator over the summer.
7. Thu - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Please, pray for the Tennessee Team, as they return to the USA on this day from Dublin.
8. Fri - **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** - Pray for my fundraising, so I can stay in Wales!
9. Sat - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Our second son's class will do first Holy communion on May 9. Please pray for his class, the services and the preparations. Please help the students, teachers and parents understand the true meaning behind communion.

10. Sun - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - We are having some interactions with neighbours and parents of our kids classmates about our upcoming leaving. Pray that we will have an opportunity to share Christ with them.
11. Mon - **Cymraeg (Welsh 4)** - Please be praying for friends and connections we've made in the coffee shops in our locations. Some of them from Costa asked if Welsh 3 and I wanted to go hangout with the staff after work hours. God has built these relationships to this point. Now pray that we are available and bold to continue investing in their friendship but more importantly their souls.
12. Tue - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 1)** - We only have a few weeks left before we get really busy this summer. Pray that we will use our time wisely and be able to spend a lot of time with our friends and neighbors.
13. Wed - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Please pray for our children as we prepare to leave the country at the end of the school year. Help us to be patient with them and to be good listeners and counsellors for them as we say goodbye and pack.
14. Thu - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 1)** - Please pray for our team as we prepare for all of our summer students. Please pray for all of the logistics to work smoothly.
15. Fri - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Please pray for us as we pack and downsize our things. Help us to be wise and frugal.
16. Sat - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Please as some of the first students for the summer arrive on this day.
17. Sun - **Cymraeg (Welsh 4)** - One of the boys who hangs out with us, and isn't a believer agreed to read the bible with C and me. So we have him a bible and explained the story of Gods word with him. He has started hanging around a lot, and even goes to youth group now too. God is doing something there. Please keep him in your prayers!!
18. Mon - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Pray that God will give us strength and grace for this task.
19. Tue - **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** - Pray for R and M, pastors at our local congregation.
20. Wed - **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** - Pray for language learning, because it is at the core of what we do.
21. Thu - **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** - Pray for our Welsh Christian friends.
22. Fri - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Pray that we say our goodbyes well.

23. Sat - **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** - Pray that we will continue to build relationships and become a part of our community.
24. Sun - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 1)** - We have spent a lot of time praying, worshipping, and studying the Word with our not-yet believing friend lately. Pray that God will radically transform his life and bring him closer to the Kingdom.
25. Mon - **Cymraeg (Welsh 4)** - Please be praying for the young welsh believers. After having conversations with a lot of them, you get a sense of excitement for church planting and spiritual movement. Ask that God will use them in mighty ways!
26. Tue - **Cymraeg (Welsh 4)** - The church we are partnering with is starting new student worship on Sunday nights. It is a new step in trying to make their Sunday night service less traditional. Please pray that this transition will go smoothly and God will be glorified through worship.
27. Wed - **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** - Pray for me as I connect with believers to find financial support to stay on field.
28. Thu - **Cymraeg (Welsh 4)** - Praise! My parents got to come on a 10 day visit. It was much needed for my heart and very helpful to our ministry here even.
29. Fri - **Cymraeg (Welsh 4)** - I ran into my friend M the other day. We used to hang out all the time but it has been a while. He is 23 years old and is unsure what to do with his life. Please keep in your prayers, and ask that I get to spend more time with him.
30. Sat - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Please pray for another group of students for the summer, who arrive in Wales on this day.
31. Sun - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Please, pray for me as I share in the Word with Caersalem Chapel in Caernarfon in the morning and the Bro Aled community service in the evening.
