4. Sat - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Pray for our kids as they adjust to life in America after four years in Ireland. Pray for their emotions and spiritual growth.
5. Sun - **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** - Please pray for a friend of mine. I really want him to know Jesus.
6. Mon - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Please, pray for our first group of summer students, who will be finishing their assignments during this first debriefing time. They will be returning to the USA on the 6th. Pray for safe travel and good reunions, upon their return.
7. Tue - **Cymraeg (Welsh 4)** - Pray for the young guys and girls from the Caernarfon area. For the believers and non-believer who are getting to experience God more and more through good community. Ask that this community and ultimately the body of Christ grows.
8. Wed - **Cymraeg (Welsh 5)** - Praise God! He is surprising us and providing for us to get to Wales! Our support raising has been going well, and we are encouraged.

9. Thu - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 1)** - This summer has been incredibly busy for us. Pray for meaningful conversations despite this chaotic time of year.
10. Fri - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Pray for God's provision of a house and car for our family during our Stateside Assignment which begins this month.
11. Sat - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Please, pray for our second large group of students arriving today for their summer projects. Pray for safe travel and smooth entry into the UK for their time in country.
12. Sun - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Pray for those in our Irish village and surrounding area who are seeking Truth. May they find Jesus.
13. Mon - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Please, pray for our second large group of summer students as they are in their training/orientation week during this time.
14. Tue - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 1)** - We give thanks for all of the amazing opportunities our summer students have had this year. They have been able to spread the gospel broadly throughout the country.
15. Wed - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 1)** - Please pray for the people who have heard the gospel this summer through our students. Pray that their hearts and minds would be open to the message.

17. Fri - **Cymraeg (Welsh 5)** - We are traveling to another state to meet with potential partners. Pray God will move in people's hearts and they will understand His love for the Welsh. Pray they will want to be involved in our ministry.
18. Sat - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Please, pray for me as I'll be speaking to the Anglesey Prayer Network on this evening.
19. Sun - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Please, pray for me as I'll be sharing in the Word with the brothers and sisters at Penrallt Baptist Church in Bangor this morning and evening.
