5. Sat - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Please, pray for N and me, as we're working hard to finalize all the paperwork for our registered charity status in the UK.
6. Sun - **Cymraeg (Welsh 4)** - Please pray for C, one of the guys I mentor. He is praying about doing a year internship with a few churches in south Wales.
7. Mon - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** – Please, pray for me as I will be diligently working to have my current residence vacated and cleaned, before moving in with colleagues in Caernarfon.
8. Tues - **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** - We're traveling to a nearby town to meet with friends and ask them to be our partners. Please pray that God will open schedules and hearts.
9. Wed - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 1)** – We give thanks for the opportunity to celebrate Thanksgiving with our neighbors and friends. We had an amazing time of

fellowship during two different dinners. We were able to pray, give thanks, and share with each other.

10. Thurs - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Pray for our connection with churches and partners during our ministry time in the States.
11. Fri - **Cymraeg (Welsh 4)** - I found out that there are two guys on my rugby team whose families are believers; pray that God can use me to show them Jesus.
12. Sat - **Cymraeg (Welsh 5)** - Please pray for new friendships with Welsh speaking friends in Bangor. We've just begun spending time together; so pray for deep and strong relationships. Pray also that we continue to meet new Welsh speakers and connect more deeply with our community.

14. Mon - **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** – Pray for my financial support. Without it, I couldn't do my work here.
15. Tues - **Cymraeg (Welsh 6)** - Welsh 5 and I are developing friendships with a couple of Welsh speakers. My prayer is that these developing friendships would develop into healthy fruitful relationships through which they'll see Jesus.
16. Wed - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Pray for our children--that the time we are in the States will help them grow spiritually. Also pray they get quality time with our extended family.
17. Thurs - **Cymraeg (Welsh 4)** - Praise God that our youth leadership course has finally kicked off! It has gone well so far, and the students have given good feedback.
18. Fri - **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** - Pray for everyone who financially supports me! They're an awesome team doing amazing work.
19. Sat - **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** - Please pray that we reach 80% of our monthly support goal by the end of the year. We want to be able to apply for missionary training school soon!
20. Sun - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** – Pray for God to meet our needs financially. Pray for new monthly partners.
21. Mon - **Cymraeg (Welsh 6)** - I'm currently looking into a couple different activities that are more specific to my interest, like a basketball team, or a film club. My

prayer is that through these types of outlets, I would meet and make friends with people that I can share my interests with and celebrate Jesus through these avenues.

22. Tues - **Cymraeg (Welsh 5)** - Pray for my teammate and I as we transition to a new supervisory structure.
23. Wed - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Our sending agency is searching for a new president. Pray for wisdom for all involved.
24. Thurs - **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** - Please pray for my family and our first Christmas without my dad.
25. Fri - **Cymraeg (Welsh 5)** – Please pray for safe travels and peace of mind during my first holiday season abroad.
26. Sat - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** – Pray for travelling mercies for several of us, who will be taking a little “goodbye” trip together, before I depart from Wales for a while.
