4. Thurs - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 1)** - Please pray for us during this time of transition with our organization. Pray for wisdom and guidance for our leaders, and pray for those left behind after the voluntary retirement and the hand raising offers.
5. Fri - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 1)** - Pray for those currently attending our Bible study. Pray that God would reveal Himself in a clear and mighty way.
6. Sat - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Please, pray for me, as I'll be meeting with some of our long-term partners in Florida about the new configuration of our ministry among the Celtic languages speakers, as well as speakers of other European minority languages.
7. Sun - **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** – Pray for some new connections in my new neighbourhood.
8. Mon - **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** - Pray that God will continue to widen our circles and bring us new financial partners.
9. Tues - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** – Please pray for God to open the door for a new visa to return to Ireland for another term.

10. Wed - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Please pray for me as I'll be meeting with some potential new ministry partners in East Tennessee.
11. Thurs - **Cymraeg (Welsh 4)** - Pray that I will trust in God to continue to work in these people's lives in Wales far after I leave.
12. Fri - **Cymraeg (Welsh 5)** - Please pray for mighty movements of the Spirit in North Wales and in the University where we are doing ministry.
13. Sat - **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** - Pray that God will continue to unite us as a team.
14. Sun - **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** – I've lost some financial support. Pray God provides.
15. Mon - **Cymraeg (Welsh 6)** - Welsh 5 and I are putting together a Scripture reading plan for the semester. Pray that we would be diligent, and it would be fruitful!
16. Tues - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 1)** – Pray that God would speak clearly to us and that we would know His will.
17. Wed - **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** - Pray we get new team members.
18. Thurs - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Pray that our time in the States reenergizes us, builds our faith, and that we have good connections with family and financial partners.
19. Fri - **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** - Pray that God will come through in a mighty and surprising way, and that we'll be fully funded by April.
20. Sat - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 1)** – Pray for us as we prepare to go to the states for a mobilization trip. Pray for safe travel, and pray that this missions conference would be a great time of encouragement and refreshment.
21. Sun - **Cymraeg (Welsh 6)** – Pray that as we get back into language training, the Lord would help us to transition back into the routine well!
22. Mon - **Cymraeg (Welsh 5)** - Please pray for discernment and wisdom about where to invest time and energy this spring.
23. Tues - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** – Pray for a friend in Ireland who is dying of cancer. Pray he truly understands that salvation is by grace and not works.

24. Wed - **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** - Please, pray for me as I speak with potential sponsors and partners about my own financial support and also for a large, proposed project in the Caernarfon area of North Wales.
25. Thurs - **Cymraeg (Welsh 6)** – I want to make spending time with a kid from Caernarfon a priority. His name is Allen. I'm praying that friendship would be fruitful for the both of us!
26. Fri - **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** – Pray we will rely fully on the Spirit and not try to do anything on our own power.
27. Sat - **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** - I'm in a new place of responsibility with my work. Pray I'm able to bear it adequately.
28. Sun - **Cymraeg (Welsh 5)** - Please pray for joy in the Lord and the Gospel and that this joy may be evident and inviting to others.
29. Mon - **Gaeilgeori (Irish 2)** - Pray that our own children will know the Lord and live for Him.
