2. Mon – **Cymraeg (Welsh 6)** – Pray for my older sister as she travels to Wales for a visit! Also, that we would enjoy our time together.
3. Tues – **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** – I've had some health issues lately. Please pray I can get well.
4. Wed – **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** – Pray for our visa! We hope to have it by now – God provides.
5. Thurs – **Cymraeg (Welsh 5)** – Please pray for local, young Christians to grow and be a strong generation of leaders in Wales.
6. Fri – **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** – Please, pray for me, as I'll have 3 wisdom teeth and a molar surgically removed. Pray for a quick recovery.
7. Sat – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1)** – We still do not have a visa to return to Ireland. Pray for a change in the system that will allow us to apply from the States.
8. Sun – **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** – Please, pray for all of our mothers on this day, as many of us are far away from our loved ones at this time.
9. Mon – **Cymraeg (Welsh 4)** – Please be in prayer for us as we adjust to life in a new/unknown field after leaving such a fruitful ministry.
10. Tues – **Cymraeg (Welsh 6)** – Looking towards the imminent return to the states, there are some logistical details I need to sort through, such as school, housing, and work. Pray that I would trust the Lord in these details, but that I would be taking ownership and initiative as I try to iron out plans.
11. Wed – **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** – Please pray I can connect with some of my neighbors.

12. Thurs – **Cymraeg (Welsh 5)** – Please pray for a coffee shop church endeavor that we're working on with a local church. Pray that the members of the church enthusiastically adopt the idea and sustain it after we're gone.
13. Fri – **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** – Training is over! Give thanks to God for faithful teachers and friends along the road.
14. Sat – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1)** – Pray for financial provision as many supporters have stopped giving during our stateside assignment.
15. Sun – **Cymraeg (Welsh 4)** – Please intercede for these things: jobs, a car, and a church community to join.
16. Mon – **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** – Please, pray for me as I try to make new connections with churches and ministries in North Carolina during May.
17. Tues – **Cymraeg (Welsh 6)** – Pray that, as I try to make plans that need to be made for my return, I would appropriately balance them with making the most of my remaining time here.
18. Wed – **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** – I have hit a serious deficit in my sponsorship. Please pray that people will respond to God's call and partner financially with me.
19. Thurs – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1)** – Pray for our village in Ireland. We long to see the Spirit move among our friends and neighbors and among all Irish language (Gaeilge) speakers.
20. Fri – **Cymraeg (Welsh 4)** – Our wedding is in two months, but it will feel like no time until it is here. There is still a little more preparation to be done, and on top of that we have quite a bit of traveling around to do so we can talk to churches and Christian organizations about our experience in Wales.
21. Sat – **Cymraeg (Welsh 5)** – Please pray for discernment about how best to use our remaining time in Wales.
22. Sun – **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** – By now our fundraising should be complete. Pray for faithful supporters as we move to Wales.
23. Mon – **Cymraeg (Welsh 4)** – My sister is adopting two baby boys this month! Pray for spiritual movement in all of the lives involved. My sister and brother in law, the children, and their birth mothers.
24. Tues – **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** – Please pray for our national partners.
25. Wed – **Cymraeg (Welsh 6)** – R and I really want to be doing certain missional activities quite often in our last bit here. We understand that it's the Lord who works in situations and in people's hearts, so pray that he would work through our efforts!

26. Thurs – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1)** – Pray for our spiritual life as a family. We need to be strong and ready to go when the door is open. Pray for our kids to truly know the Lord.
27. Fri – **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** – Our final days in the U.S. are here. Pray for time well spent with family and friends.
28. Sat – **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** – Please pray for clarity with my role on the team.
29. Sun – **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** – Please, pray for me as I network and build partnerships with various other missions agencies and organisations in our efforts to build our personnel on field through strategic partnerships.
30. Mon – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1)** – Pray for our friend who is the only evangelical Irish language (Gaeilge) speaker that we know: to be encouraged and effective in witnessing to her family and friends.
