1. Fri – **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** – We've found a house to rent, but we have to wait while the owner decides whether or not to sell instead. Pray that God leads us to the right place.
2. Sat – **Cymraeg (Welsh 5)** – Please pray for continuing readjustment to life back here in the US.
3. Sun – **Cymraeg (Welsh 6)** – Pray for our Welsh friends that don't know Jesus but have been reading scripture. Pray that God would make himself more and more known to them, and that they would continue to search.
4. Mon – **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** – Pray for a potential outreach initiative in Caernarfon.
5. Tue – **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** – Please, pray for me and my mother as we travel a rather long distance, returning from a family vacation in New York.
6. Wed – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1)** – Every day hundreds of thousands of Irish schoolchildren hear Scripture read aloud as part of the curriculum. Pray that God uses his word to plant a seed in their hearts that leads to new life in him.
7. Thu – **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** – Pray for those attending a festival starting in Caernarfon today. People from all over Wales will attend and we'll have the opportunity to serve alongside our friends here.
8. Fri – **Cymraeg (Welsh 5)** – Please pray for I and G, two Welsh friends that had just started reading the Bible with us when we left. Pray that they'd continue that together and connect with local believers.
9. Sat – **Cymraeg (Welsh 6)** – I got a job working at a coffee shop in Dallas! I start my training the 1st of July. Pray that I would catch on quick and that I would use it as a platform for the Gospel.

10. Sun – **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** – Please, pray for me as I'll be speaking about our new ministry with the Churches of Indian Creek Baptist Association in Waynesboro, TN.
11. Mon – **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** – Pray for new financial partners. I'm still way under budget.
12. Tue – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1)** – Pray for a friend who is the parish secretary for the local priest. She types out dozens of Scripture verses every week to put in the order of service. Pray God speaks to her through his word.
13. Wed – **CeLT-Wide** – Pray for our unity in Christ and as a team, despite the thousands of physical miles that lay between many of us.
14. Thu – **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** – Pray for a family event at chapel on Saturday. Pray for opportunities to love people in the same way God loves us.
15. Fri – **Cymraeg (Welsh 5)** – Pray for Ystafell Fyw, or "Living Room," a newly started Cafe Church in Bangor.
16. Sat – **CeLT-Wide** – Many of us are in the thick of fundraising, either for new ventures in our ministry or to renew support to meet our monthly needs. Pray that we keep our eyes on Jesus as our ultimate Provider.
17. Sun – **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** – Pray for some new partnership opportunities.
18. Mon – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1)** – Pray for a friend who is the only believer in her family and Irish speaking village. Pray for her confidence in sharing Jesus with family and friends.
19. Tue – **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** – Pray for us as we set up our home, that it becomes a place where God's love and grace is manifest in every detail.
20. Wed – **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** – Please, pray for me as I continue to do fundraising both for my own personal missionary support, but also for start-up funds for our ministry in Wales and beyond.
21. Thu – **Cymraeg (Welsh 6)** – Pray for me as I continue to adjust back to life in the states. It can be a bit odd at times, but I really want to be obedient to serve the Lord in whatever capacity he has me do that here.
22. Fri – **Cymraeg (Welsh 5)** – Please pray for Capel y Ffynnon, that they would passionately seek the Lord and love the people in the Bangor area.
23. Sat – **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** – Pray for our current national partners.

24. Sun – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1)** – Pray that the local priest will be born again as he studies God's word. That is how the Reformation in Europe began and we pray for it to happen with our local priest.
25. Mon – **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** – Pray for our new friends and neighbors. God is speaking to them already, pray that he helps us listen along.
26. Tue – **CeLT-Wide** – When He saw the crowds, He felt compassion for them, because they were weary and worn out, like sheep without a shepherd. Then He said to His disciples, “The harvest is abundant, but the workers are few. Therefore, pray to the Lord of the harvest to send out workers into His harvest.” Matt. 9:36-38
