1. Sun – **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** – Pray for me, please, as I share with the folks at Walker Baptist Church in Franklin, TN.
2. Mon – **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** – Pray for the young families that visit our chapel. Many come and go, pray that we make the most of each opportunity to welcome and include them.
3. Tue – **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** – Pray for new local friends and disciples.
4. Wed – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1)** – We are grieving the loss of an Irish friend. Pray, as the gospel has been shared in his family. Pray for his wife and children.
5. Thu – **Brezhonegerien (Breton)** – Pray for Brest and the Breton-speakers who live there, especially in these dark months of winter. Pray for the light of Christ to break through in unexpected places.
6. Fri – **CeLT-Wide** – Pray that our team continues to grow in love and unity, even in the small things.
7. Sat – **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** – We'll be at training for the next few days starting tomorrow. Pray that we have open hearts ready to be taught and that we're encouraged from other people's experiences.
8. Sun – **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** – This is my mother's birthday, and I'm mentioning it because I'd like to ask you to pray that my remaining time with her and other family members in the USA before returning to Wales will be meaningful and a blessing to all.
9. Mon – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1)** – In our extended absence from Ireland pray for God to send more workers to the Irish speaking areas.
10. Tue – **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** – Pray for Linguæ Christi, as it develops into a new charity.

11. Wed – **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** – Please, pray for me as I will be sharing about our ministry at First Baptist Church, Englewood, Tennessee.
12. Thu – **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** – We're travelling today and have a couple tight connections. It's a small thing, but pray that we get home smoothly.
13. Fri – **Gaelgeyrn Vannin (Manx)** – Pray for *Doolish* (Douglas), the capital of the Isle of Man and for the Manx Gaelic speakers who live there.
14. Sat – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish)** – Pray for *Gaillimh* (Galway) and the Irish-speakers who live there.
15. Sun – **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** – Please, pray for me as I will be spending this time with our sponsoring Church, First Baptist Church Orange Park, Florida, as well as other Churches in the area.
16. Mon – **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** – We're back in Welsh class. Pray for opportunities to serve and encourage people here.
17. Tue – **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** – Pray for new, full time team members.
18. Wed – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1)** – Pray for the priest in our Irish village to truly know God as he is still very influential with many families.
19. Thu – **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** – Please, pray for guidance and resources to take care of some of the big things that I'll need immediately upon my return to Wales (like a car and a place to live - neither of which is worked out at this point).
20. Fri – **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** – There are two families in our village that we want to get to know better. Pray for open doors.
21. Sat – **Gaidheil (Scots Gaelic)** – Pray for the city of *Inbhir Nis* (Inverness), the unofficial capital of the Highlands in Scotland. Pray for God's spirit to move among Gaelic-speakers there.
22. Sun – **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** – Pray for guidance to reach new Welsh speakers.
23. Mon – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1)** – Our children are still in weekly contact via technology with several kids in our Irish village. Please pray for continued gospel sharing opportunities. It is happening so join us asking God to move there.
24. Tue – **Cymraeg (Welsh)** – Pray for Pwllheli, the Welsh-speakers who live there, and the believers who are sharing God's love there.
25. Wed – **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** – Please, pray for travelling mercies and all that is involved in travelling, as I return to Wales (from Atlanta to Manchester). Lord willing, I'll arrive in Manchester on the 26th, then on to Wales.

26. Thu – **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** – Pray for a friend in the village grieving the loss of a family member.
27. Fri – **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** – Pray for our local ministry partners.
28. Sat – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1)** – Pray as we recruit and train in the States that we can send many to Celtic people groups.
29. Sun – **CeLT-Wide** – The winter days are dark. Pray that the light in us shines brightly.
30. Mon – **Kernewegerien (Cornish)** – Pray for Kammbronn (Camborne) and its neighboring towns and villages in Cornwall. Pray that God speaks through his creation directly to the hearts of Cornish speakers.
