1. Wed – **Cymraeg (Welsh)** – Today is St. David's Day in Wales. Our prayer today is to be faithful in the "little things" – such were St. David's parting words before his death in the 6th century.
2. Thu – **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** – Please, pray for us as a Team as we have some opportunity to meet and pray with some of our Welsh ministry partners in the area.
3. Fri – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 2)** – Pray that we would all travel and transition well to our new home.
4. Sat – **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** – Pray that I receive some timely wisdom to follow Jesus in ministry.
5. Sun – **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** – Please, pray for me, as I'll be preaching this morning at the Eglwys Efengylaidd in Eglwysbach. This is also St. Piran's Day in Cornwall. Pray too that God would plant a desire for himself in the hearts of Cornish speakers.
6. Mon – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1)** – Pray for those feeling a call to serve in Ireland – for confirmation, support, and preparation. Pray for God to prepare hearts of Irish speakers before they arrive.
7. Tue – **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** – Please, pray for several of us on the Team, who will have the opportunity to participate in a Welsh-language television programme.
8. Wed – **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** – Pray for the friends we've made in our village, that we speak words of compassion and truth to them each time we meet.
9. Thu – **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** – Pray for new ministry partners.
10. Fri – **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** – Please, pray for a couple of us on the Team who will be having some important meetings in Cardiff over these couple of days that our discussions would bear fruit for the Kingdom.

11. Sat – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1)** – Pray for new financial partners for our family.
12. Sun – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 2)** – Pray as I attend a Bible intensive for learning and training others to understand God's Word.
13. Mon – **Cymraeg (Welsh 5)** – Our friend M is a fully-professing Christian, working in Liverpool in a cafe and with a local church. It's been in the months since we've come back that he's made the decision to follow Christ. Praise God for his response and pray that he continues to listen to God's voice.
14. Tue – **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** – Pray for our continued efforts to learn Welsh. Praise God for the little moments he gives us when everything clicks into place.
15. Wed – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1)** – Pray as we recruit and train new workers for the CeLT and other teams in our role stateside. Even our oldest son is helping with Second Language Acquisition so pray for him, too.
16. Thu – **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** – Pray for my grandmother. She's been very ill for a couple months now, though slowly improving.
17. Fri – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish)** – Today is St. Patrick's Day, celebrated across the world now but originally from Ireland. St. Patrick's story offers encouragement, even across the centuries, for St. Patrick too was sent to Ireland. Pray that God would send more ambassadors of his Good News to this island.

19. Sun – **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** – Pray for boldness and courage, tempered with kindness and wisdom.
