2. Sun – **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** – Pray I can connect to Welsh speaking students in Manchester.
3. Mon – **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** – Please, pray for a Trustee Meeting of Linguæ Christi this afternoon.
4. Tue – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1)** – Pray as we continue our role in pre-field training that we are effective in preparing new workers.
5. Wed – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 2)** – Pray our kids would do well as they restart their schooling since our move.
6. Thu – **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** – Thank God for how he's provided for us and pray that even in the little things (like driving tests) we thank him for his faithfulness.

8. Sat – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1)** – Pray for our family's spiritual life and especially as we disciple our children.

19. Wed – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 2)** – Pray as I seek temporary employment to build our support for the field.
20. Thu – **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** – Pray that God connects us with families who he's calling to serve in our corner of Wales.
21. Fri – **The CeLT** – Thank God for all of our supporters, near and far. Thank him for his faithfulness through the Church.
22. Sat – **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** – Please, pray for me, as I'll be preaching in Capel Groes and Capel Saron in the Bro Aled area tomorrow morning and afternoon respectively.
