1. Mon – **The CeLT** – Pray throughout the month of April for our team as together we lay the groundwork for an expanded ministry across many different areas in the coming future.
2. Tue – **Brezhonegerien (Breton)** – Pray for the town of *Montroulez* (Morlaix) and Breton speakers who live and gather there.
3. Wed – **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** – Pray for our church as we grow and make changes to meet our growing needs.
4. Thu – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 2)** – Pray for strength and wisdom as I learn to minister to men struggling with addiction.
5. Fri – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1)** – Pray for Irish speakers in Connemara – that God will be gracious and send more families to share the gospel and live there long term.
6. Sat – **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** – Some of our friends and former colleagues are visiting in the area, and we're looking forward to spend some time with them and the team they're bringing with them to North Wales.
7. Sun – **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** – Pray that our charity bank account gets approved.
8. Mon – **The CeLT** – Then He said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to the whole creation." Mark 16:15
9. Tue – **Kernewegoryon (Cornish)** – Pray for *Porth Ia* (St. Ives) and the Cornish speakers who live and gather there.
10. Wed – **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** – Pray for the relationships we already have and the courage to share the Gospel without fear of rejection.

11. Thu – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1)** – Pray for strength for the few native speaking Irish believers. Pray they have the burden to reach their families and friends. Pray for a clear strategy for that ministry.
12. Fri – **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** – Please, pray for us as we make some important decisions about 1 or 2 of our student summer projects coming up this year.
13. Sat – **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** – Pray for new national partners. We need some more people on our team.
14. Sun – **The CeLT** – I give thanks to my God for every remembrance of you, always praying with joy for all of you in my every prayer, because of your partnership in the gospel from the first day until now. Philippians 1:3-5
15. Mon – **Gaelgeyrn Vannin (Manx)** – Pray for the Isle of Man and Manx speakers who live there. Pray for the story of Jesus in the Manx language.
16. Tue – **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** – Pray for continued opportunities to meet people in our village.
17. Wed – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 2)** – Pray for discernment as we make a decision concerning specialized training.
18. Thu – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1)** – Pray for renewal in the Irish Catholic church, for many priests and members to truly know the Lord and be moved to share and live the gospel.
19. Fri – **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** – Please, pray for some more students to sign up for our projects this summer.
20. Sat – **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** – Pray that those we're discipling come to know Jesus.
21. Sun – **Gaidheil (Scots Gaelic)** – Pray for *Muile* (Mull) in the Outer Hebrides of Scotland. Pray for Gaelic speakers and for the Gospel of Christ among them.
22. Mon – **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** – Pray for our faithfulness in the weekly tasks and meet-ups.
23. Tue – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1)** – Pray for our personal support needs. Our support has plummeted since being located in the States doing training and recruiting.
24. Wed – **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** – Please, pray for some new participants for our Vision Trip planned for potential ministry partners later in the summer (July).
25. Thu – **The CeLT** – Let us remember Jesus' parting words on Ascension Thursday. "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come on you, and you will be My witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." Acts 1:8
26. Fri – **Cymraeg (Welsh 2)** – Pray for new financial supporters.

27. Sat – **Cymraeg (Welsh 3)** – Pray for our students as they raise funds and make preparations for joining us this summer. Pray that God begins to work in their hearts for the experiences they'll have here.
28. Sun – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 2)** – Pray we would see the Father's plan more clearly every day.
29. Mon – **Gaeilgeorí (Irish 1)** – Pray for the spiritual life of our family, especially the younger kids who are not yet believers. Pray we have wisdom in leading them to Christ without pushing them in our urgency. Pray we can trust God's timing.
30. Tue – **Cymraeg (Welsh 1)** – Please, pray for good opportunities to meet new friends and neighbours and for bridges to the Gospel through these new friendships.
