Study: Building evidence for updating Canada's disease classification system in primary care

Feedback from family physicians is critical for exploring potential options to replace the ICD-9 coding system used in primary care settings.

- International Classification of Disease version 11 (ICD-11) developed by the World Health Organization (WHO)
- International Classification of Primary Care Version 3 (ICPC-3) developed by the World Organization of Family Doctors (WONCA)
