ADULT TB SKIN TEST

The State Department of Health Services requires that adults having regular contact with groups of children have a Mantoux Tuberculin Skin Test (TST) or Interferon Gamma Release Assay (IGRA) blood test sixty (60) days or less before the start of that contact, and every four (4) years thereafter.

There are several locations that administer TB tests at varying fees, including your general practitioner, medical clinics, or the Santa Clara County Public Health Department (408) 792-5200. A TB test is required for each person who will be working in the classroom.
