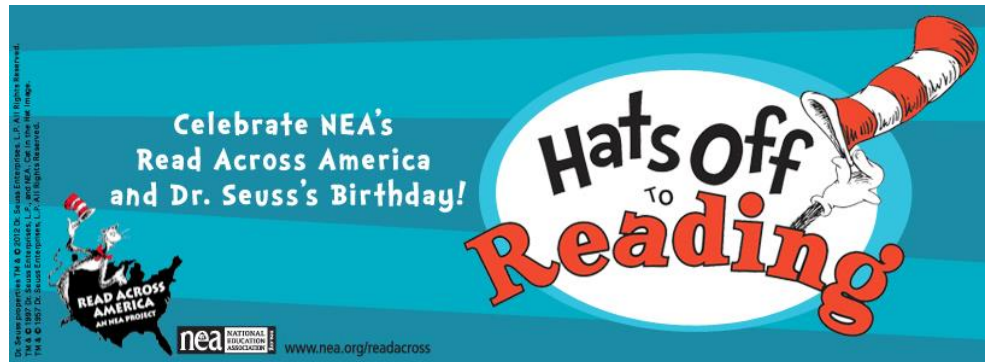

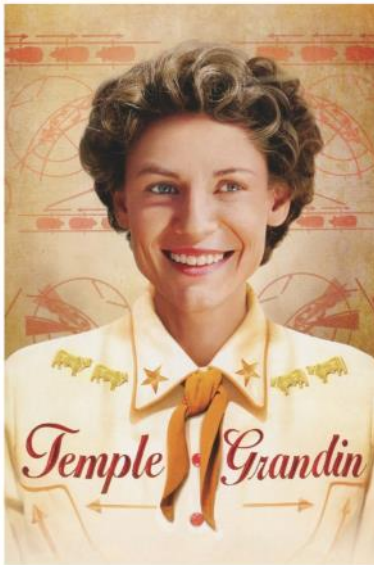

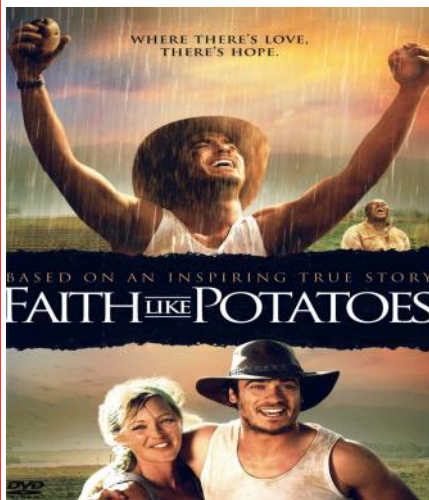


WELCOME
