- 1. **Sybil Lane** (5 lots) Andy Prolman in attendance (Attorney for the property owners Paris/Richard Families) Mr. Prolman is asking LCC to pay the \$1,500. tax due for the property. Mr. Prolman gives a brief history the permit process to develop the property was denied, there is 5 acres mostly wetlands. The property owner wishes to donate to LCC. Mr. Prolman went to the Board of Selectmen they are not interested in accepting the donation with \$1,500., outstanding taxes. Andy Prolman told BOS the taxes were inaccurate, BOS states the LCC should pay \$1,500. The fence Mr. Normanton wants to put up on this particular area of the property is to keep the animals contained for agricultural use. Joan McKibben Motions LCC to send letter stating we do not object to the fence, LCC in favor do to agricultural use, Tom Levesque seconds the Motion, Motion carries 6-0-0.
