10/30/2013 site visits in Litchfield for possible habitat enhancement for NE Cottontails
11/25/13 Joan tours Town with representatives from NRCS, Hillsborough & Rockingham County Conservation Districts and Fish and Game. The site walk with NRCS, Litchfield Conservation Commission. The areas at Moore's Falls and the Litchfield Muster Field will be enhanced to make suitable habitat to encourage the introduction and healthy habitat for the New England Cottontail in these areas.
