  - 6 full dumpsters of mixed waste
  - 1 truck of reusable items for the Community Warehouse
  - 24 lbs of batteries
  - almost a ton of e-waste
  - 175 lbs of styrofoam
  - 60 lbs of lightbulbs
  - several truckloads of Rebuilding Center donations
  - Helping elderly and disabled neighbors
  - Raised over \$1,000 for our funds
