

## **Suggested Guide to Homeschooling through High School**

### **Grade 9 through 12**

#### **Suggested Course Credits:**

##### **4 credits of Language Arts (4 years)**

(Including grammar, vocabulary, essay and report research writing). Electives: poetry, creative writing, composition, speech, rhetoric, journalism, etc.

Literature: American, British and World

##### **3 Credits of Mathematics (3 years)**

(Including algebra 1, algebra II, geometry, statistic) Electives: precalculus and calculus

##### **3 credits of Science (3 years)**

(Including physical science, biology, chemistry, physics or career and Technical education all with a lab)

Electives: anatomy, astronomy, geology, earth, etc.

##### **3 ½ credits of Social Studies (3 ½ years)**

(Including U.S. history, geography, American government, and citizenship, world history and economics)

Electives: psychology, political science, philosophy, sociology, etc.

##### **1 credit of Fine Arts (1 year)**

(Including art history, drawing, painting, digital imaging, music appreciation, dance, drama, photography, etc.)

##### **7 Elective credits (over the 4 years)**

(Including foreign language (2 years recommended), religion, career and education planning, work skills, computer and keyboard, journalism, logic sing language, physical education, health, etc.
