RSWA WORKS WITH CITY OF VISTA, EDCO AND CLEAN HARBORS TO UTILIZE LOCAL COMPANY IN VISTA FOR ELECTRONIC WASTE DISPOSAL

The Regional Solid Waste Association (RSWA), a Joint Powers Agency composed of the Cities of Del Mar, Encinitas, National City, Poway, Solana Beach, Vista and the City of Escondido as a Special Contract Party will be using E-World Recyclers for electronic waste recycling beginning immediately. Mayor Pro Tem Frank Lopez of Vista who is also the Board Secretary for RSWA has been very interested in utilizing the local company and all the details have been worked out so that e-waste, as it is commonly referred to, will be going to E-World in Vista.

This is “win/win” situation Mayor Pro Tem Lopez stated – “we are doing the right thing for the environment by getting electronic waste disposed of properly and are using a local company which definitely helps both economically as well as with green house gas emissions by limiting the number of miles traveled.” He continued, “For our citizens the disposal process will be seamless, they still take their household hazardous waste and electronic waste to one of the two RSWA facilities in Vista or Poway or the facility in our partner city Escondido and the waste will be properly disposed of. Electronics will then be taken to E-World Recyclers in the City of Vista by the vendor Clean Harbors.”

Mayor of Poway and RSWA Chairman Mickey Cafagna commented, “Once again using a public/private partnership model with EDCO and Clean Harbors, RSWA has been successful in creating a positive benefit to the environment, while working with a local enterprise.”

Sheree Tweddell, the Vice President for E-World Recyclers, who has been attending the RSWA Board meetings, is very pleased to see the business staying local in the City of Vista.
