#### Live Performance Policy & Procedures

- Cafeteria welcomes performers of all genres and types, musical and non, however acts will be selected based on how they fit both the atmosphere of Cafeteria & of New Paltz.
- Currently we do not pay performers, however we do encourage the use of a tip jar and glad welcome you to sell any band-related merchandise you might have. In addition, coffee is on us for you and your band for the night you perform.
- In an effort to be respectful to the tenants located directly above our space, and in keeping with the “coffeehouse vibe” we do not allow drum sets, trap sets, or any other loud percussion instruments.
