



RADON PROGRAM

To help keep our neighborhood healthy and livable, the East Calhoun Community Organization (ECCO) is offering a \$50,000 grant program from Neighborhood Revitalization Program (NRP) funds to encourage neighbors to test, and if desired, treat their homes for radon.

Program Guidelines

1. Eligible Applicants: Owners of residential property in the East Calhoun neighborhood.
2. Grant Amount: East Calhoun is offering a grant program to help property owners with radon mitigation expenses. If your grant application is approved, the East Calhoun Community Organization (ECCO) will grant Neighborhood Revitalization Program (NRP) funds of **up to 25% of the costs with a maximum grant of:**
 - \$500 for 1-2 unit residential buildings
 - \$1,000 for 3-4 unit residential buildings
 - \$1,250 for 5+ unit residential buildings
3. Grant Program Details:
 - One time grant per property owner.
 - Subsidies will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis, as funds are available.
 - Property owner must obtain a bid for mitigation from a certified radon mitigation professional (a list is available at www.health.state.mn.us/radon) and complete a grant application to participate in the program. You may have to meet city permit requirements for your project (check with the contractor).
 - To be eligible, ECCO must approve your grant application before mitigation work begins. Generally grant applications will be approved within 10 days.
 - Mitigation work must be completed by a certified radon mitigation professional. A list is available at www.health.state.mn.us/radon.
 - Applicant must pay the contractor directly and is responsible for project costs in excess of the grant amount.
 - Work must be completed within 90 days of application approval for the homeowner to be eligible to receive the grant.
 - Once the mitigation work is completed, the property owner must submit the Completion Certificate and all receipts to nrp@eastcalhoun.org or East Calhoun Radon Program, 2751 Hennepin Ave S, #13, Minneapolis, MN 55408.
 - The grant reimbursement will be mailed within four (4) weeks of submission of Completion Certificate and receipts for the completed mitigation work.
