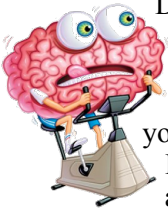

Heads up! We will, again, be participating in **Foodland’s** Give Aloha Program during the month of **September**. Foodland will match a portion of any contribution to NCC up to \$249 per Maika‘i card. If you don’t have a Maika‘i card, just sign up for one at the Customer Service desk of any Foodland or Sack ‘n Save store! All you need is a phone number (land line or cell phone). Tip for couples: In order for Foodland to match your contribution(s), you need separate Maika‘i cards. If you use the same card as your spouse, Foodland will accept the contribution, but will not match it, if the (joint) contributions are over \$249.



Contributions to Give Aloha may include your monthly (or advanced) pledges and/or extra donations. NCC will receive all contributions and matching grants in mid-October. Don’t forget to ask for a duplicate receipt so you can turn one in to the church. Make sure your name is on the receipt, and please help us by indicating if your contribution is a pledge or a donation to something else.
