GUIDELINES FOR LEONARD KAPRIELIAN GRANTS

Last Updated: October 19, 2017

The Leonard Kaprielian Grants program honors long-time Sausalito Art Festival Foundation board member and community volunteer, Leonard Kaprielian, and supports the Foundation's mission to encourage, promote, and support the arts for the community.

The Foundation makes contributions ranging in size from \$500 to \$10,000 to eligible 501(c)(3) nonprofit organizations. Grants are given to nonprofits operating in Sausalito and to programs or projects that support, sponsor, or create art-related activities in the community.

Proposals must include ALL of the following:

- Brief description of the organization's mission and primary programs.
- Complete description of the project or program for which funding is being requested, including specific goals, intended audience, number of people served, and a timeline.
- Proof of 501(c)(3) status.
- Copy of the organization's most recent financial statements (audited if possible).
- Current operating budget.
- Program- or project-specific budget.
- Additional funding sources for the program or project with amounts specified.
- Names and affiliations of the organization's Board of Directors.

Please use the above checklist to ensure your proposal package is complete! Incomplete proposals will not be considered for funding.

Complete proposal packages should be post marked or delivered to the SAF Foundation office by 5:00PM on Monday, December 4, 2017 to be eligible. Late proposals will not be considered. Phone solicitations are not accepted.

2016 SAFF Grantees: We must have a 2016 Final Grant Report on file for your organization in order to consider a proposal for funding in 2017.
