Inclement Weather: Please take a moment to read the following message regarding storms and the potential dangers associated with them while at the swim club. Share this information with your teenage children if they are at the pool alone—especially if they are walking home or riding their bikes. Make them aware of the risks and let them know their options before they get stuck in a storm!

Summertime is notorious for severe thunderstorms. During these storms, I ask that our members exercise caution and good judgment when planning their visit to the pool. If possible, please allow yourself ample time to arrive home safely before the storm hits. If you are unable to leave before the storm starts, you are welcome to seek shelter in the bath houses (do not use the showers during the weather event). Often times, members rush to their cars to seek shelter from the rain and begin their journey home. Please be aware of our patrons (especially children) dashing through the parking lot, as it can be a scene of chaos and confusion.

If your children walked or rode their bikes to RSSC, please encourage them to REMAIN at the swim club and contact an adult to pick them up—the office phone is available for children to call for a ride. Our driveway is surrounded by trees and large limbs, which can create a dangerous situation for those attempting to leave. Limited visibility of drivers' can pose another danger to pedestrians and people on bicycles.

The safety of our members is ALWAYS my primary concern, please use the best judgment for you and your family during inclement weather at Rock Spring Swim Club.
