

## 'Acrylics for vibrant wildlife and botanical art' with Marijke Greenway

WABA is offering a two day workshop with experienced Australian artist Marijke Greenway. With Dutch and South African heritage, Marijke has lived in Australia since 1988. She has painted prolifically, often "en plein air" and has accumulated an impressive list of awards and commendations for her work. Marijke has exhibited in both group and solo exhibitions, published in art magazines and she is a member of a number of art societies.



The two day workshop will focus on both wildlife and botanical subjects using acrylic paints:

**Day One: Bush Stone-Curlews** – an unusual Australian bird with characteristic postures and camouflage colours. These birds have recently been reintroduced at Mulligans Flat, having been locally extinct for 50 years.



**Day Two: Gum blossom at Uluru** – enjoy painting different poses of these beautiful flowers.
