# felted POINSETTIA ornament

## SUPPLIES

- **red and green felt**  
felt made from old sweaters is preferable, but you can use thin sheets of store bought felt as well.
- **5 inches of decorative ribbon**  
approx 1/8-1/4 in. wide
- **1 button**  
white or yellow
- **thread**  
white or green
- **needle**
- **fabric glue**
- **scissors**

## INSTRUCTIONS

**step 1** – cut 2 of the flower pattern pieces using red felt. cut one of each leaf pattern using green felt.

**step 2** – lay one flower piece on top of the other, then rotate so the petals peek through underneath. with a needle and thread, sew the button onto the 2 flower pieces starting at the back of the second flower.

**step 3** – arrange the small leaf on the back of the flower so that the tip peeks through. using green thread, stitch the leaf only through the back flower layer. make small stitches in a circle about the size of a nickel.

**step 4** – with fabric glue, glue the large leaf on top of the small leaf to hide the stitches you made in step 3.

**step 5** – to hang the ornament, fold the decorative ribbon in half and make a knot approx 3/4 in. down on the loop end. spread apart the 2 ends of the loop and wrap around the button center point between your 2 layers of flower felt. tie another knot to secure and trim off excessive ribbon.
