HOLIDAY STOCKING board

SUPPLIES

- [May Arts ribbon \(www.mayarts.com\)](http://www.mayarts.com)
 - 2 yds - 1.5" green scalloped ribbon (EN46)
 - 2.5 yds - 3/4" aqua velvet corduroy (357-34-04)
 - 2 yds - 1.5" green grosgrain dots (DD32)
 - 1 ft - 3/16" green grosgrain/stripes (RG46)
- **Bazzill**
 - button stackers - tree bird
 - tag stickers - holiday style
- **wood board - 7.5" x 30"**
add 10" per additional stocking
- **white paint**
- **3 wooden thread spools**
- **decorative paper**
- **double sided tape**
- **glue**
- **3 flat headed screws .5" longer than spool.**
should fit in spool, but head should not go through
- **3 screw eyes**
- **ruler**
- **scissors**



INSTRUCTIONS

- step 1** – lightly paint your wood board white
- step 2** – cut .75" x 3" strips from decorative paper and wrap around center of thread spool. secure in place with double sided tape.
- step 3** – cut 8" strips of polka-dot ribbon, slightly overlap edges and lightly glue in place. layer 3 ribbon loops and space them evenly apart on the board.



step 4 – hold wooden spool firmly against ribbon loops and screw down through the spool. (if you don't apply pressure while screwing, the ribbon might turn with the screw and get caught up.)



step 5 – using 3/16" ribbon, secure creme button circle to the tree button. tying with a knot on the back side. glue small bird on top of the tree and once dry, glue button unit on top of the wooden spool.



step 6 – glue corduroy ribbon around the outside edge of the board.

step 7 – choose 3 Bazzill tag stickers and center them above each thread spool. this will be where you write the stocking owner's name.

step 8 – cut a small slit into the corduroy ribbon centered above each wooden spool. insert a screw eye into each slit and tighten.

step 9 – string 1.5" green scalloped ribbon through screw eyes and secure with a knot at the top.

step 10 – hang board on a secure nail to showcase your stockings.
