RIBBON SHADOWBOX ART

SUPPLIES

- [May Arts ribbon \(www.mayarts.com\)](http://www.mayarts.com)
 - 1 ft - white wired pom-pom (PM01)
 - 1 ft - yellow wired pom-pom (PM27)
 - 1 yd - yellow velvet ric-rac (WR27)
 - 2 suede leaves - green (XL16)
- [Graphic 45 products](#)
 - kraft reflections paper pack
 - metal button staples
- [double sided adhesive "pop dots"](#)
- [print out of a vase 3" tall](#)
- [8.5" x 6.5" decorative shadowbox](#)

INSTRUCTIONS

step 1 – trim a piece of paper from the pack to 6" x 8". adhere to the inside of the shadowbox with hot glue placed in the 4 corners and press.

step 2 – cut out your vase graphic and attach to the background using 2 adhesive glue dots. (these dots place the vase 1/4" off the background and create a 3- dimensional look.)



step 3 – place hot glue in the center of where you want your flower. taking the yellow pom-pom ribbon, press end into the glue and then bend to form 3 loops. place hot glue in the middle each time your pom-pom wire crosses the center. repeat with your white wired pom-pom ribbon, placing the loops between the yellow loops.



step 4 – take a metal button and press the 2 ends up into the inside of the button. fill inside with hot glue and press over the center of your flower.



step 5 – cut a tiny piece of paper for the stem and glue in place between the flower and the vase. with hot glue, adhere both suede leaves where they meet on top of the stem. place a adhesive glue dot under the top leave to raise it off the page.

step 6 – trim a quote out of you paper stack and attach to your background with 2 adhesive glue dots.

step 7 – secure lid onto shadow box and attach yellow velvet ric-rac around the outside of the box using your hot glue gun and you are finished.
