

# CITY OF NATALIA

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Mandatory Language for Monitoring and Reporting Violation  
Failure to Submit Disinfectant Level Quarterly Operating Report (DLQOR)  
**MONITORING, ROUTINE (DBP), MAJOR/CHLORINE**

The CITY OF NATALIA Water System PWS ID 1630009 has violated the monitoring/reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, maintain acceptable disinfections residuals within the distribution system, monitor the disinfectant residual at various locations through the distribution system, and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results or regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from microbial contamination.

This violation occurred in the monitoring period: 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter, July 1 ó September 30, 2017.

We are taking the following actions to address this issue:

This issue was corrected on November 1, 2017. The disinfectant level quarterly operating report due date for 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter was October 31, 2017; report was submitted to TCEQ one (1) day past the submission deadline.

Please share this information with all other people who drink this water, especially those who may not have received this notice directly (i.e., people in apartments, nursing homes, schools, and businesses). You can do this by posting this notice in a public place or distributing copies by hand or mail.
