CSDA students and their parents meet inside the theater. We are normally sitting down in front to your right when you enter the theater. Students should sit with their class in this area. Parents should leave the seats in this area available for other students. Parents please sit in the next section towards center so we can find you if we need you for help.

Students must be ready to dance 1 hour prior to their listed time allowing for any unforeseen schedule changes. **ALL STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO STAY FOR THE AWARD CEREMONY!**

HAIR AND MAKE-UP INFO:

- ❖ **Students must have hair and make-up done and be dressed in their first costume at their specified arrival time.**
- ❖ **Hair must be neatly styled with absolutely NO FLYAWAYS-use hair gel.**
- ❖ **Company - Center part, no bangs, hair slicked back into a low bun at the nape of the neck**
- ❖ **JTR & JTR too! –Center part, no bangs, hair slicked back into a low bun at the nape of the neck**
- ❖ **Ballet Ensemble - Center part, no bangs, hair slicked back into a low bun at the nape of the neck**
- ❖ **New JTR, JTR too! dancers and Invited Competition Dancers - Center part, no bangs, hair slicked back into a low bun at the nape of the neck**

Female participants should wear the same jewelry as they wore in the HOLIDAY SHOW and MUST wear FALSE EYELASHES and mascara. (See CSDA staff for “Eyelash Questions”).

Parents are responsible for their child’s behavior at the competition.

No flash photography or videotaping allowed!

There are point deductions for videotaping a routine.

Video cameras will have to be removed from the facility.

All competitors are expected backstage, lined up and ready to go at least five numbers before their own. All contestants in costume should wear cover-ups in the competition theater. Please remember that contestants must be responsible for proof of age. In the case of a challenge, you must be able to prove age or disqualification may result.
