

AWB Volunteer Grant

Application Requirements:

1. **Statement of Intent:** Write a 500-600 essay explaining how the proposed project supports AWB Canada's mandate. Describe what you hope to gain from this experience and why you feel it will be useful in your career as an architect, designer, or planner.
2. **Project Selection:** Provide evidence supporting the credibility of the community partner or organization that you have chosen for this project. Give examples of their current and past work. Describe what your role will be in the project. Include correspondence with the organization to prove that you have made contact with them.
3. **Curriculum Vitae:** Include relevant education, employment, travel history, leadership and volunteer experience in your curriculum vitae.
4. **Budget:** Submit a budget outlining project costs, transportation, lodging, food, and other expenses. Include the duration of time you plan to spend abroad or volunteering. The committee is aware that the cost of the volunteer experience may be more than the award of \$2000.00.
5. **Letters of Reference:** Provide two letters of reference supporting your character, skills, and experiences that make you an ideal candidate for the award.
6. **The Responsibility of Awarded Member:** The recipient of the AWB Volunteer Grant will be required to give a 20-minute presentation at a General AWB meeting upon return. They will also be required to submit a 500-word essay describing lessons learned through the AWB funded experience.
