Requirements: All A/OK instrumental students are expected to:

1. Attend rehearsals consistently. (Leaders should be notified by phone in advance if possible of absences for illness, etc.)
2. Behave courteously in class.
3. Attend Sunday School faithfully each week at The Salvation Army.
4. Be responsible for the proper care of music and instruments provided. (Students should not allow other friends or family members to play their assigned instrument. It is an expensive instrument,)
5. If instrument is damaged because of carelessness or not putting it away properly when not in use, the student will be responsible to pay for any repairs needed to return the instrument to working condition.
6. If music is lost or damaged, the student will be expected to pay the cost of a new book.
7. Practice daily (4-5 times a week for at least 15 minutes a session.)
8. Be present to perform on special Sunday programs when scheduled.
9. All students who meet the above requirements are encouraged to attend Summer Music Conservatory at The Salvation Army's Camp Heart O'Hills. Transportation is provided and scholarships are available to those who qualify through faithful participation and progress.

I realize that if I do not abide by these policies I may not continue to qualify for the program and will surrender the instrument provided for me if requested at any time.
