

Call for Poster Presentations

Maine Association of Wetland Scientists CALL FOR POSTERS

Thursday, March 23, 2017 – Bowdoin College, Brunswick, Maine

The Maine Association of Wetland Scientists (MAWS) is issuing this Call for Posters for presentation at the MAWS 2017 Winter Conference and Annual Meeting – a one day annual forum that includes discussions on a wide range of topics led by natural resource regulators, professionals, and graduate students on a wide range of natural resource topics related to science and management.

TOPIC AREAS – The theme of the 2017 Annual Meeting is “Wetlands Restoration” but all wetland-related science topics are encouraged.

Examples of poster topics include:

- Wetlands
 - science and habitats
 - wildlife or plants
 - invasive species management/control
 - threatened or endangered species habitat/management
 - hydrology
 - erosion/sediment control
- Vernal pool science and habitat
- Marine and estuarine science and habitats
 - Salt marshes
 - Freshwater tidal systems
- Rivers, streams, and riparian science and habitats

GENERAL GUIDELINES AND EXPECTATIONS – MAWS is welcoming individuals, students, or small groups from **academic or professional research** to present posters. Presenters must attend their posters during the review session in order to discuss their project and facilitate interaction with meeting attendees.

The poster should be well-organized and visually pleasing. It should include key information such as name, phone number, email, affiliation, location and type of poster: research or project. Attendance at the meeting is required for poster presenters. Posters should be set up no later than 11:30 am (ideally in place for the entire Winter Conference, approximately 8:30 am – 3:30 pm, easels with backboards and clips will be provided). A buffet lunch will be provided. The poster session will begin at noon and will last approximately 90 minutes.

REGISTRATION – The event will be held in Thorne Hall (Building 67) at Bowdoin College. To register a poster presentation, please send a short (one paragraph) synopsis of your project via email to danielle.tetreau@stantec.com by February 17, 2017. Presenters will be notified of acceptance by February 24, 2017

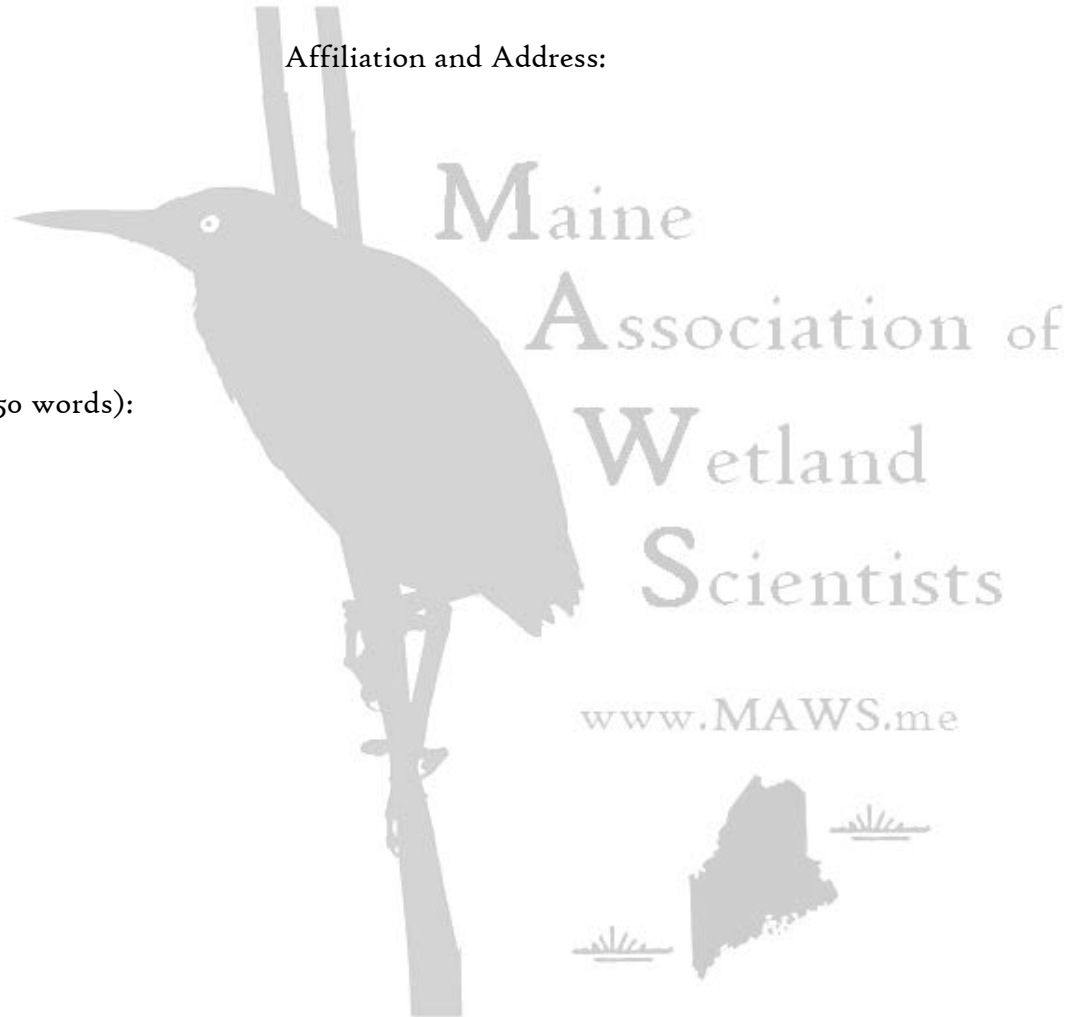
