The Maine Department of Environmental Protection is seeking to fill an Environmental Specialist II position within the Division of Water Quality Management (DWQM), Compliance and Technical Assistance Unit in Bangor.

**BRIEF JOB DESCRIPTION:** This position is a compliance inspector for the Maine Pollutant Discharge Elimination System and Waste Discharge Licensing Program (MEPDES/WDL). The position inspects licensed municipal, commercial, and industrial wastewater treatment facilities and aquaculture pen sites. This position is responsible for monthly review of compliance data, identifying and documenting non-compliance events for Department review and action, reviewing draft wastewater permits, investigating and resolving complaints, performing water quality sampling in the field, participating in educational outreach activities, and project review for facility upgrades. The position interacts closely with licensing, enforcement, technical assistance and engineering staff in the DWQM and water quality engineers in the Division of Environmental Assessment. The position also interacts closely with the regulated community and other interested parties.
