The Moore Road property remains on the market with a few showings; we will keep the congregation informed as news develops.


Thrivent has established a new grant program that may prove to be beneficial for many of the projects that occur at Redeemer during the year. This program has great potential, but needs a Thrivent member to serve to coordinate the program operation. The council is seeking a Thrivent member to serve as a coordinator for this program. If you are a Thrivent member and are interested in serving in this capacity, please contact James Caldwell, our Christian Care Elder or myself and we will provide additional information.

Redeemer is part of the Arizona Lutheran Academy federation; we were recently approached by the ALA board regarding a unique opportunity for ALA to acquire land adjacent to the campus that will extend the property to Southern Avenue. This is a hoped for opportunity many have prayed for over a number of years and now that the opportunity to purchase the property at a discounted price has been made available, the ALA board has established a fund drive to raise the required purchase price before the end of September. Please take a look at the “Gaining Ground” material in the church narthex. If you are moved to give, Redeemer will match donations up to a combined total of \$10,000 to support this effort. We have been greatly blessed during this school year with increased tuition tax credits that have reduced the amount of congregational support required by the school, thus this opportunity to support the ALA effort is possible. Our recent financial issues have hindered the ability to provide the level of support to the ALA federation that we would prefer; this is an opportunity to show our support for the federation.

Redeemer has been blessed with many visitors worshiping with us. Please take the opportunity to introduce yourself and make our visitors feel welcome.

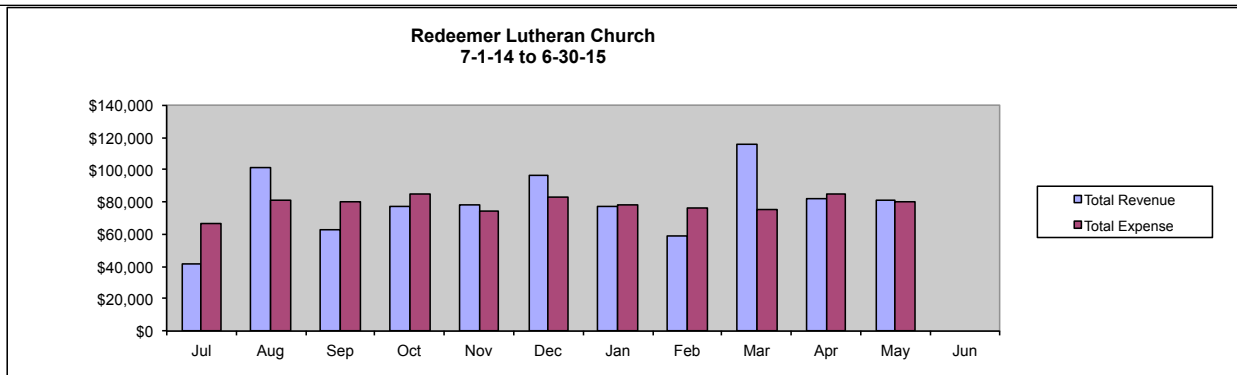
