OUR EXPECTATIONS FOR STUDENTS

An important part of every child's faith life is his participation in Sunday and festival worship services. We ask that parents realize their responsibility in this regard and attend church regularly with their children. Occasionally, the children will participate in Redeemer Lutheran's worship services. All children will be asked to attend church on that day. Parents should excuse their child in advance if they are unable to participate. We ask that all parents be willing to support the efforts and activities of the school and support the continuing spiritual growth of their children and themselves by setting an example in church interest and attendance. All children are also encouraged to attend Sunday school regularly. The Lutheran elementary school and Sunday school are coordinated to work together for the child's spiritual growth.

OUR EXPECTATIONS FOR PARENTS

It seems natural that all parents would be interested in the course of education their children will follow in school. We feel this is especially true in the area of religion since parents are responsible for the spiritual training of their children. Redeemer Lutheran has as its main objective to assist parents in this their God given responsibility. POLICY OF NON-DISCRIMINATION

Redeemer Lutheran School admits students of any race, color, national and ethnic origin to all the rights, privileges, and activities generally accorded or made available to students at the school. It does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national or ethnic origin in the administration of its educational policies, admission policies, and athletic or other school related programs.

REGISTRATION

A non-refundable registration fee of \$100, which is separate from tuition, is due upon registration for enrollment. By returning this form with your \$50 deposit (*per child*) by **Friday, March 11th**, you will receive a \$100 credit toward registration. However, if this form is not received by March 11th, a \$100 deposit will be required.

TUITION FEE SCHEDULE

A tuition fee is required of all students. The tuition fee for the school year 2016-2017 is all inclusive of tuition and book fees. The purpose of the tuition fee is to provide Redeemer Lutheran Church with the school's portion of salaries, utilities, maintenance, capital improvements, janitorial services, secretarial services, insurance, mortgage payments, and costs of educational supplies necessary for school operation (*including such items as textbooks, workbooks, art supplies, science supplies, athletic supplies, and fees for participation in athletic leagues*).

Tuition may be paid in full at the beginning of the school year, split in half with half due in July and the other half in December, or may be paid in ten equal installments via credit card or automatic withdrawal from a checking or savings account, where the first payment is scheduled to be made in July and the final payment in April. You are required to set up a form of payment prior to Redeemer's registration day (or your child's first day of school should his/her enrollment occur during the school year). To set up a form of payment, please complete the necessary form(s) in the school office. Your child will not be able to attend school until this set-up process is complete. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.

Tuition for the 2016-2017 school year is as follows:

* The maximum out of pocket for a parent/guardian will be \$2,000 (plus \$1,000 for each additional child) provided the parent/guardian agrees to redirect their Arizona income tax liability through a School Tuition Organization (STO), such as ACSTO, designating Redeemer Lutheran School as the recipient. We also ask that each parent/guardian bring in one donor (per student) outside of Redeemer Lutheran Church and School who would also designate Redeemer Lutheran School as the recipient. If these terms are met, the most any parent/guardian will pay for tuition is the maximum out of pocket amounts described above.
