The Doric

The Doric is Edinburgh's oldest gastro-pub, built in the 17th century; it was originally used as a shop selling various linens and materials. By the beginning of the 19th century, the building became a pub for the first time, serving cooked meals from as early as 1823.

The idea was simple; Use fresh, local produce to feed the masses, as well as ales, wines and of course whisky.

Today is no different, we still use local produce, always fresh, and always cooked to order, and always serving the best of Scottish tipples.

The word 'Doric' is a form of dialect used mainly in Aberdeenshire, Scotland, and is a regional twist on the English language. Despite being located in Edinburgh the pub was named 'The Doric,' as it was a home away from home for travelling Aberdonians in times past.

Over the years the name of the bar on the ground floor has occasionally changed, The Central bar and more recently McGuffie's Tavern until it became what we know today.

In January 2010, the bar was given a complete refurbishment, aiming at recreating a more traditional 'antique' pub, a little closer to what it would have been like to all those working loons and lassies all those years ago.
