

Highland

Aberfeldy 12 years old – £4.30

40% A clean and polished malt with a touch of honey and spice.

Blair Athol 12 Year Old – £4.30

A flora and fauna release from the Blair Athol distillery, this 12 year old exudes sherry and Christmas pudding notes with spice. A small release malt that more people need to know about.

Dalmore 12 years old – £4.25

40% It is smooth and full bodied with a hint of sherry in its malted flavours.

Dalwhinnie 15 years old – £4.40

43% Ideal as a pre or postdinner dram, it is light with a heatherhoney finish.

Edradour 10 years old – £4.10

40% Delicious aroma of sugared almonds. A dry, light taste with a mellow finish.

Glengoyne 10 years old – £3.80

40% A light, sweetish whisky with a fragrant aroma and no abrasive edges.

Glengoyne Cask Strength – £7.75

58.9% Floral opening with stronger finish of cinnamon and caramel. Very balanced and cask strength only adds to the offering.

Glenmorangie Lasanta 12 Year Old – £5.75

43% An Oloroso sherry finished whisky from Glenmorangie, the word 'Lasanta' derives from the Gaelic for Warmth and Passion.

Glenturret 10 years old – £4.10

40% An award winning, fullbodied malt with delicately rounded finish.

Glen Garioch Founders Reserve – £4.05

48% Honeyed sweetness, hints of heather and a touch of spice.

Glen Garioch 12 years old – £5.20

48% Heathery floral notes are balanced with the richness of poached pears and sweetness of malted barley. Crème brulee, sweet ripe banana followed by light oakiness with pear fruitiness.

Glen Garioch 1991 – £9.95

54.7% This 1991 vintage picked up five stars from Class magazine, who call it "dry . . . with smoky charred wood/peat and apple fruit".

The Macallan Gold – £4.10

40% This burnished gold spirit is packed with vanilla and citrus flavours.

Oban 14 years old – £5.00

43% An intriguing, complex malt with a full island character and soft highland finish.

Springbank 10 years old – £4.35

46% Technically a Campbeltown malt, this classic whisky is smoothly complex.

Speyside

Aberlour 10 years old – £4.00

40% A smooth, rich, sherried malt which is an ideal afterdinner drink.

Aultmore 12 years old – £6.60

Aultmore is the first release from the Dewar's distillery for a few years and is elegant, light and fruity.

An Cnoc 12 years old – £4.10

40% It's dryish aroma is complimented by a mellow sweetness in flavour.

Balvenie Doublewood 12 years old – £4.25

40% A fullbodied, yet smooth whisky with beautifully combined flavours.

Balvenie Caribbean Cask 14 Years Old – £6.75

43% The process of transferring to Rum casks in this process has created a well-rounded and drinkable whisky with notes of fruit and vanilla. Absolutely superb.

Benromach 10 years old – £4.10

43% Well balanced with rich sherry influences and hints of fruit.

Cragganmore 12 years old – £4.10

40% A malt of distinctive and complex character, with a delicate, smoky finish.

Glenfarclas 10 years old – £4.00

40% A whisky of true character, and widely acknowledged as a classic malt.

The Glenlivet Founders Reserve – £4.15

40% Fresh floral notes with a hint of vanilla and an enticing richness.

The Glenrothes – £5.15

43% A popular, full bodied malt with peated aroma and smooth aftertaste.

Craigellachie 13 years old – £6.50

Citrus, herbal with slight dried fruit on the palate. Finish is quite long. oaky & dry.

Islay

Ardbeg 10 years old – £4.65

46% A dominant peaty aroma with orangey overtones and a sweetly balanced smokiness.

Bowmore 12 years old – £4.10

40% A perfectly balanced Islay malt. Delicious subtle peat smoke with hints of honey, lemon and vanilla.

Bowmore 15yr Darkest – £6.65

43% A beautiful balance of flavours: delicious dark chocolate, sundried fruit and a telltale wisp of Islay smoke.

Bowmore 25 years old – £29.95

43% This is an exquisite Bowmore that has been matured for a quarter of a century in North American bourbon and Spanish sherry casks. Intense sherry and stewed fruits with a trace of peat smoke.

Bowmore 18 years old – £8.95

43% Creamy caramel toffee, with ripe fruit and smoke aromas. Incredibly complex, with beautiful soft fruit and chocolate balanced with a light smokiness.

Island

Highland Park 12 years old – £4.15

40% Has a floral fragrance with hints of heather and spice. Honeyed to the palate.

Isle of Jura 30 years old – £30.00

55% A highly premium malt. Its woody notes are surpassed by lingering tastes of toffee.

Jura 10 years old – £4.15

40% Reminiscent of a Highland malt, its light, fragrant palate is ideal as an aperitif.

Jura Prophecy – £7.75

46% Punchy, peated herbal notes and dry smoke dominate this malt.

Ledaig 10 Year Old – £5.35

46.3% Maritime and smoky, this rivals some of the Islay drams for power, and the 10 year old balances the intensity of youth with rounded, well-aged spirit.

Talisker Storm – £5.95

45.8% Talisker Storm has all the warm, smoky, peppery characteristics we all love in the standard Talisker 10yo – but they've been turned up a notch, with more smoke, more spices, and a bigger than ever flavour explosion.

Talisker 10 years old – £4.40

45.8% Alluringly sweet and fullbodied with a warming afterglow.

Tobermory 10 years old – £4.00

40% It has a smooth and flowery aroma with drier, spicy tones.

Bunnahabhain 12 years old – £4.15

40% Less characteristically peaty than other Islay malts, a mellow & aromatic drink.

Caol Ila 12 Year old – £5.20

43% Caol Ila 12 Year Old is of medium weight, but still packing plenty of potent phenols, this is a refined, powerful dram with a compensating oiliness. A balanced, peaty beauty.

Lagavulin Distillers Edition 1998 – £9.95

43% Bottled in 2014, this 1998 edition of Lagavulin's Distillers Edition (probably the most sought after in the range) combines the regular rich, peat smoke that the distillery is known for with a finishing period in sweet Pedro Ximenez sherry casks for even more depth of flavour.

Lagavulin 16 years old – £5.50

43% Powerful and demanding, with a dominant aroma and a trace of sweetness.

Laphroaig 10 years old – £4.40

40% A robust, classic Islay with a trace of seaweed in its strongly peaty flavour.

Lowland

Auchentoshan 12 years old – £4.10

40% Light, delicate and smooth due to triple, rather than conventional double distillation.

Auchentoshan Three Wood – £4.95

43% Maturation in three different casks gives this whisky a rich complexity with incredible toffee and sherry oak flavours.

Auchentoshan 18 years old – £8.95

43% A refined malt with notes of gooseberry, sweet creamy vanilla, warm honey and the signature smooth delicate Auchentoshan taste.

Auchentoshan Virgin Oak – £11.50

46% Placed in brand new oak casks right from the start, Auchentoshan threw the dice and won with their new Virgin Oak release. Instead of maturing in a cask that previously held sherry or bourbon, like most whiskies are, they did something different and have luckily created something stunning.

Deanston Virgin Oak – £4.95

46.3% Deanston Virgin Oak is made with young whisky which has been finished in brand new oak casks from Kentucky. They are certified by the Organic Food Association and power their distillery using hydro energy, so you can always feel good about the delicious dram in your hand.

Glenkinchie 12 years old – £4.10

43% This Edinburgh malt is the smokiest of the lowland whiskies. A fine, smooth drink.
