### Light, Crisp, Easy-Drinking Whites

1. Pinot Grigio, Cosmina 2013, Romania £21.50  
*A deliciously fresh, dry white with crisp apple and pear flavours. The palate is light, juicy and vibrant with refreshing hints of grapefruit and pineapple.*
2. Soave, Villa Molino 2013, Italy £21.50  
*Pale straw in colour with a delicate fruit bouquet and a fresh, dry subtle flavour.*
3. Verdejo Duquesa, Bodegas LAN 2014, Spain £25.00  
*Wonderfully dry with fresh acidity, this Verdejo is bright and crisp with fabulous citrus flavours of lemon and grapefruit.*
4. Picpoul de Pinet, Terrasses de la Mar 2015, France £27.50  
*Light and delicate in style with a hint of peach and apricot on the finish.*

### Medium-Bodied Whites with Good Fruit Characters

5. Sauvignon Blanc, First Dawn 2015, Marlborough, New Zealand £28.00  
*A classic Kiwi Sauvignon Blanc, packed with vibrant citrus and grassy flavours along with refreshing acidity and a crisp, dry finish.*
6. Sios Pla del Lladoner, Bodegas Costers del Sio, 2014, Spain £32.00  
*Subtle and elegant with fresh citrus and soft, floral aromas. Plenty of long-lasting fruit flavours in the mouth.*
7. Sancerre, Domaine Hubert Brochard 2014, France £29.50  
*The wine offers grapefruit, lime, spice and mineral notes. On the palate you find fresh citrus, honey, spices, minerals and even a hint of herbal tea. Overall, this wine is beautifully balanced with good length.*
8. Chablis, Domaine Long Depaquit, Albert Bichot 2014, France £37.50  
*Bursting with mineral precision and finesse. A very pure nose that has aromas of white flowers which opens up to a palate that boasts an elegant combination of almond notes and lovely vivacity.*

### Full-Bodied Whites with Great Depth of Character

9. Grüner Veltliner, Leitz Moser 2014, Austria £29.00  
*Grüner Veltliner is Austria's own grape variety. This example shows exuberance with spicy-peppery notes. Youthfully fresh in its acidity.*
10. Mary McTaggart Riesling, Woodstock 2013, Australia £34.50  
*This dry Riesling is floral and fruity in style with a nice freshness and a hint of spice.*
11. Pouilly Fuissé, Domaine Parisse 2011, France £39.50  
*Everything you would expect from Pouilly Fuissé, an elegant balance of stewed apple fruit and spice; fresh, clean minerality, and buttered toast notes from the new oak ageing.*

### Rosé Wines

12. Rosado Ecologico, Mureda 2013, Spain £4.50 £5.80 £17.50  
*A balanced, fresh and intense flavour with a sweet and long aftertaste.*
13. Rouviere Rosé, Château Routas 2014, France £23.00  
*Freshly cut watermelon, ripe peach aromas and floral notes lead to a palate alive with wild strawberries and hints of mineral notes. Crisp acidity and a refreshing finish.*
14. Côtes du Rhône Rosé, La Grivelière, Maison Brotte 2014, France £27.00  
*Notes of citrus fruits, sweet almond and red cherry. Well-structured with a ripe wild strawberry finish. This is a youthful wine with impressive length.*

### Dessert Wines

15. Sweet Raquel, Torreón de Paredes, Chile £19.50  
*Aromas of candied orange and honey, the sweetness on the palate is balanced and refined.*

### Lighter, Easy-Drinking Reds

16. Beaujolais Villages, Heury Fessy 2014, France £26.50  
*Soft and light with raspberry fruit. A classic French red that slips down very easily!*
17. Homestead Pinot Noir, Jackson Estate 2013, New Zealand £35.00  
*Concentrated aromas of bright red fruits dominate the palate combined with dried herbs and underlying spice. The flavour is rich and ripe with plums, cherries and ripe red fruits. Light tannins leading into a full and lingering finish.*

### Medium-Bodied Red Wines with Good Fruit Characters

18. Château Brande Bergere 2012, France £24.00  
*Deep red colour with a nose of the forest fruits, well-structured and rounded on the palate, very elegant with a good mouthfeel.*
19. Chianti Toscana 2013, Botter, Italy £25.00  
*From the heart of Tuscany, this is an excellent red wine to serve with food. It is medium-bodied with lovely, cherry fruit flavours.*
20. Carménère Reserve, Santa Ema 2014, Chile £25.50  
*This epitomises the quality which Chile can offer. Superb balance and concentration of black cherries, herbs, spicy black pepper and a touch of chocolate.*
21. Le Gagie Barbera d'Asti, Tenuta La Meridiana 2012, Italy £30.00  
*Deep ruby/red colour, persistent in the mouth with spicy and vanilla notes.*
22. Rioja Reserva, Bodegas Beronia 2011, Spain £32.50  
*There are hints of chocolate, toasted bread and spice on the nose and a smooth, gentle finish.*
23. Lalande de Pomerol, Château Siaurac 2012, France £50.00  
*A Merlot-dominated Bordeaux blend of great fame. A wine of intense dark fruit and spice, yet still very well-structured and elegant.*

### Full-Bodied, Well-Structured Reds

24. Pinotage, De Waal Young Vines 2012, South Africa £25.00  
*Silky, smoky flavours on the nose, followed by concentrated berries and spice on the palate.*
25. Les Creus, Bodegas Costers del Sios 2012, Spain £29.50  
*Made from a fine blend of finest quality Tempranillo and Garnacha grapes, this is a juicy, fresh, red with plenty of ripe raspberry, boysenberry and blackberry fruit with a good dash of mineral complexity.*
26. Shiraz (Dark Chocolate), Chocolate Box 2012, Australia £34.50  
*Strong aromas of coffee, chocolate, blackberries and spice fill the glass, supported with sweet, vanilla oak. A long, silky smooth finish awaits all...*
27. Gigondas, Brotte 2013, France £46.00  
*Complex, powerful and generous with its cherry liqueur hints and red berry aromas. The thinking man's Châteauneuf du Pape! Big and bold, this is what Rhône should be.*
28. Amarone della Valpolicella, Campagnola 2011, Italy £47.50  
*Selected grapes are laid down on straw mats to dry until January following the harvest. This wine has a deep garnet colour with a rich, cherry fruit bouquet followed by a full-bodied, dry and powerful palate.*
29. Château Musar 2007, Lebanon £56.00  
*Concentrated plum and blackberry fruit with hints of fig, prune and spice. Firm but fine tannins followed by vibrant, fresh streaks of cedar and cinnamon.*

### Sparkling Wine

30. Prosecco Spumante Extra Dry DOC, Botter N.V., Italy £25.00  
*Soft, effervescent and fruity. The perfect aperitif or a base for something more exotic.*
