October 30th, 2017 marked the 500th anniversary of Martin Luther sparking the Protestant Reformation by posting his 95 Theses on the church door in Wittenberg Germany. 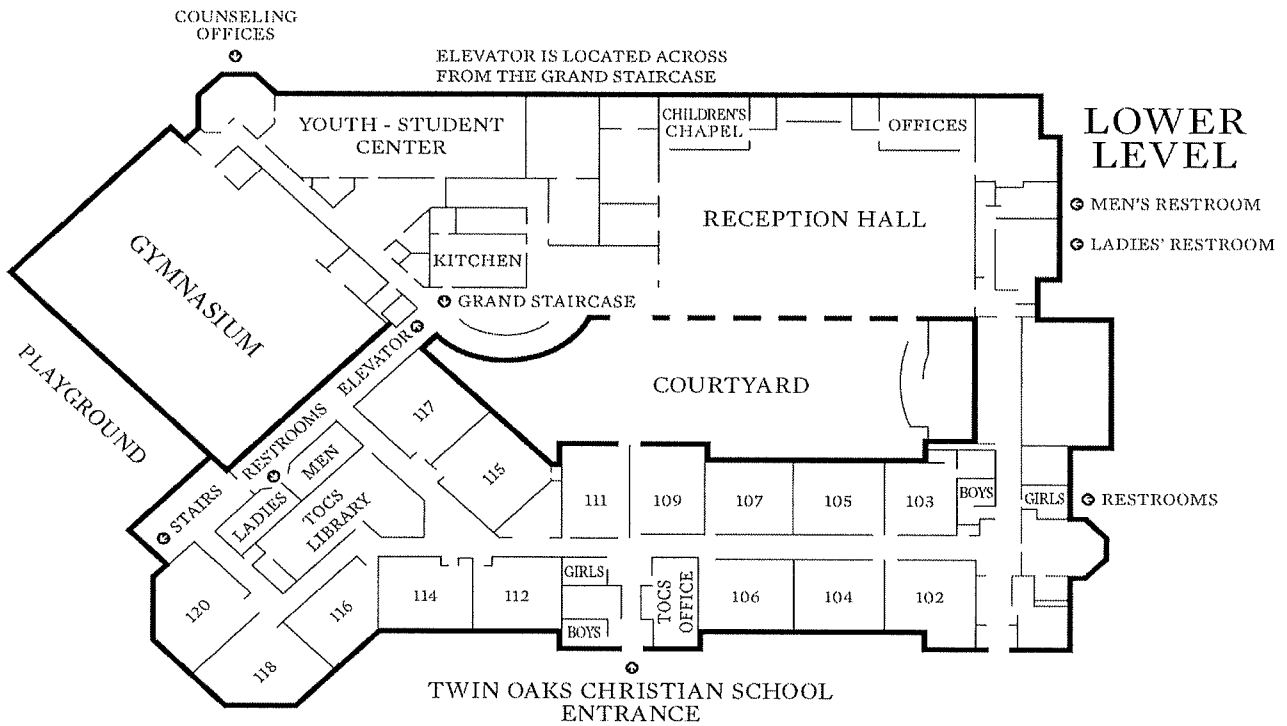
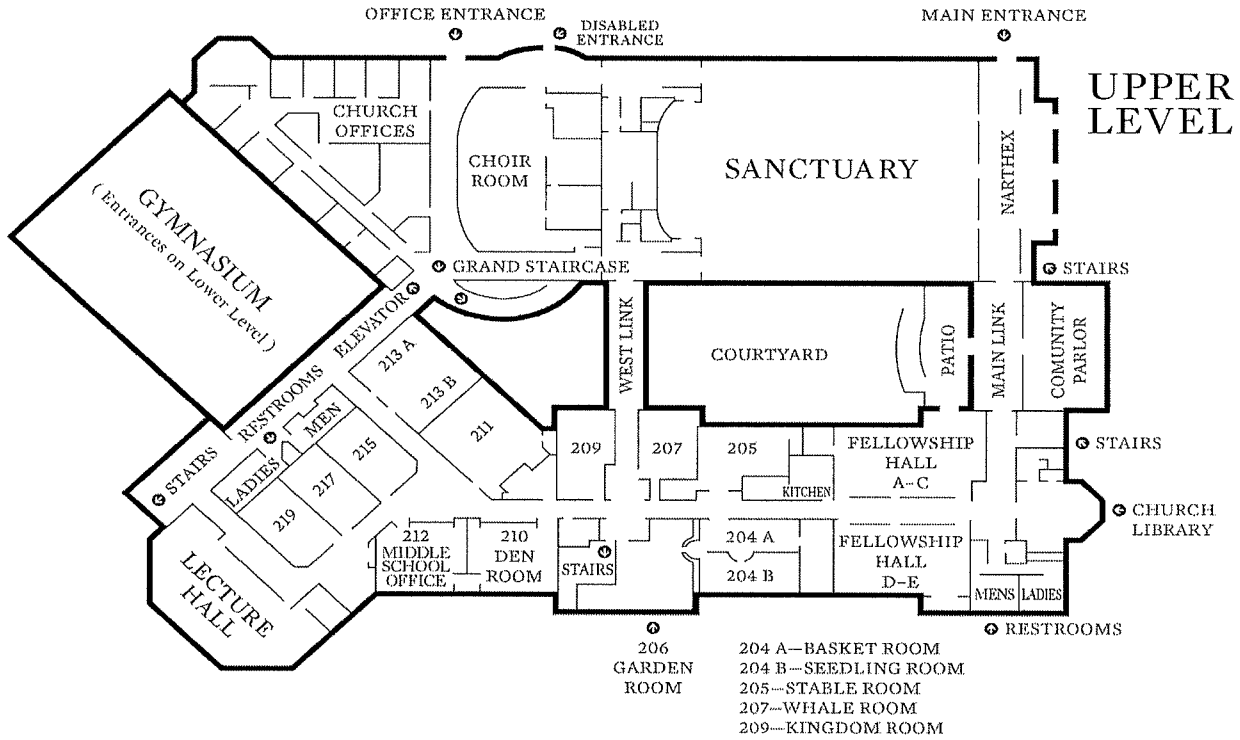
