PERSONALIZE SCRIPTURE

Spontaneous times to relate your everyday life to God's Word

Start a list of all the facts you know about Jesus. How do they compare to your own life? Was Jesus good at soccer? Did he get an A on every test? How did he react to his siblings?



WORSHIP WITH YOUR LIFE Show what God has done in your life to others

Jesus was a real person who lived a real human life. He modeled the best way for us to live. Look for ways to be like Jesus to those in your life. Show your friends and family how Jesus would have reacted or interacted.



DIALOGUE WITH GOD Prompts to pray with your family
