ARTICULATE YOUR FAITH

Intentional times to talk about God's Word

1. What facts do you know about Jesus' life?
2. Are there things about Jesus that change the way you see Him?
3. How does Jesus' life impact your faith compared to His birth or death? Does one matter more or less than the other?
4. How can the humanity of Jesus affect our view of his divinity (the fact that He is God)?



PERSONALIZE SCRIPTURE

Spontaneous times to relate your everyday life to God's Word

Start a list of all the facts you know about Jesus. How do they compare to your own life? Was Jesus good at soccer? Did he get an A on every test? How did he react to his siblings?



WORSHIP WITH YOUR LIFE

Show what God has done in your life to others
