Red Teaming the Plans

You have a plan.

Great.

Now what?

Identify the risks, threats and vulnerabilities.

Risk: is the the likelihood of being targeted by a given attack.

Threat: is what could happen.

Vulnerability: is the weakness that an adversary will exploit to make the attack successful.

3 steps to Red Team the plan.

Identify the key aspects of the plan.

Identify threats most likely to impact those parts of the plan.

Determine the vulnerabilities that might make those threats real.

Rank the parts of the plan by
criticality:

Critical - Essential - Non-Essential

ID the threats:

What can happen? When? What is most likely to happen? How?

ID the vulnerabilities:

Which of the threats identified
above have the greatest
likelihood of disrupting the plan?
How?

Rule 29:

If you're happy with your security,
so are the bad guys.

Finally, bring the 10th man.

Remember:

When in doubt, Red Team it!
