Dear Members of the Trinity Catholic College community

I write to share with you the news that Mr John Kyle-Robinson has been selected to be the next Director of Marist Schools Australia for the NSW/ACT Region. Mr Kyle-Robinson will finish in his role as Principal of Trinity Catholic College at the end of this term in order to take up this appointment at the start of 2017.

By any measure, Mr Kyle-Robinson has been an outstanding Principal of Trinity for these past five years, and someone who is held with both esteem and affection by the whole College community. He is indeed an exceptional Catholic educational leader. He has led the College with vision and heart, ensuring that Trinity continues to be a lighthouse in the evangelisation and education of young people. He is also a committed Marist whose spiritual depth and educational priorities reflect all that St Marcellin would hope to find in the Principal of a Marist school. There will be an inevitable sadness, therefore, for all at Trinity to have to bid farewell to Mr Kyle-Robinson at the end of the year as he takes up this position in the wider Marist family of schools.

In his new role Mr Kyle-Robinson will support and guide a network of twenty-two Marist schools, spread across seven Dioceses in New South Wales and the Australian Capital Territory. This Region is one of the three groups that comprise Marist Schools Australia (MSA), of which Trinity Catholic College is a member school. MSA is the main ministry of the Marist Association of St Marcellin Champagnat, the entity which these days brings together the Marist women and men who, with the Marist Brothers, continue the movement started by St Marcellin two centuries ago. MSA could hope for no-one better to join its Leadership Team than John Kyle-Robinson. Please join with me in congratulating him on his appointment.
