

## Clay County Transfer Station – for Clay County residents ONLY

“Recycling is a privilege, so please place items where they belong”

Location: Hinton Center Road, Hayesville, NC

Hours: Monday-Saturday, 8am-5pm; closed Sunday

Aluminum: cans ONLY

Antifreeze: please look for the special container

Cardboard: Corrugated AND cereal box type cardboard

Metal: Steel, appliances, lawn mowers, tin, air conditioners, etc. *NO* fencing wire, microwaves, or TVs.

Motor Oil: please look for the special container

Paper: Newspaper, office paper, junk mail, magazines

Plastics: All #1 and #2 – NO caps; containers must be rinsed and empty.

“Tin” (steel) cans: Put into the container provided, NOT in the metal section.

Tires: Stack them in the trailer behind the trash building. Four or more tires require a completed form for the state.

“Items NOT accepted (in addition to mentioned above)”: GLASS of any kind, trailers, old cars, wet paint, gasoline, campers, pesticides, medical waste, flammable substances, insecticides, ballasts, asbestos, mercury, radioactive materials, toxic wastes, acids, boats, lead paint thinner, PCBs. *If you have any of these items, tell the attendant at the window and he/she will tell you how to dispose of them.”*
