**4)**You can monitor the supplies set out or sit down and enjoy some conversation with friends.

**5)**Clean up: Most people place their dirty cups, etc. in the bus tub located at the kitchen door. Empty the coffee urn of leftover coffee and dump or compost the coffee grounds. You can recruit volunteers to bus the tables as people finish.

Load the dishwasher—and start them before you leave.
