John 20:19-31 - Jesus appears to the disciples

Day 1

John 20:19-20
The Disciples locked the doors against the Jewish leaders out of fear. What do you try to lock out of your life? What fears do you hide from?

Day 2

John 20:21-23
Jesus sends them out to continue his work. What could you do if you faced your fears?

Day 3

John 20:24-25
Who do you most identify with in this passage? Thomas who wants the same proof as the others? Or the disciples who saw and want Thomas to believe them?

Day 4

John 20:26-29
Why do you think that Thomas seems to be held to a higher standard? What does it say about how we work to pass on the stories of our faith to others?

Day 5

John 20:30-31
What in the Gospels helps you to believe? How do you share that belief?
