The Gift of Our Possessions: This is a time of year when many communities have coat drives, or winter warmth drives. When your birthday comes around, ask for toys that can be given to local shelters, or given to a local organization that gives away Christmas presents. For Christmas you could ask people to give livestock through an organization like Heifer International or give mosquito nets through the ELCA Malaria campaign, or some similar gift idea.
