Children who witness abuse in the home are much more likely to abuse their children or spouses. There are several websites that offer statistics on generational cycles of violence and abuse.

What are some constructive outlets that your household can use to avoid violent reactions to negative feelings? Try counting to 10, going for a walk or run, and working to create safe places to talk about strong and difficult feelings.
